Plan to include infographic to help parents know how they can best help the P&C dependent on how much time they have to volunteer. Each subcommittee (canteen, uniform and auxiliary) will have a dedicated section with budget, how to help and synopsis of what the subcommittee does. Budget in the 2023 plan to clearly indicate what percentage of funds should be allocated to each priority to be determined by previous data from past years spendings, last year's survey and conducting another survey specifically asking parents where they

- Prospective timeline to have the 2023 plan ready to begin Term 1 2023.

## **Fund Provision Ideas:**

- Motion to allocate \$3000 to provide every child enrolled before census date in 2023 with a free reversible hat.
